This week we will continue learning our vowels and the letters t, m, and s.

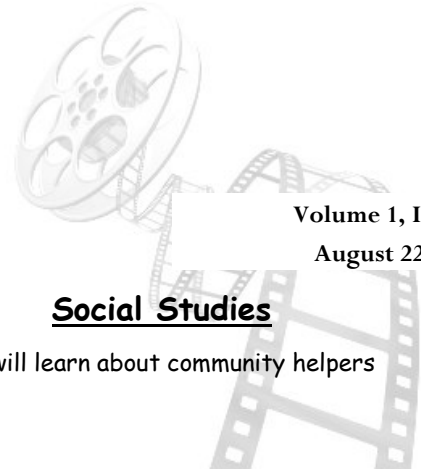
Science/Health

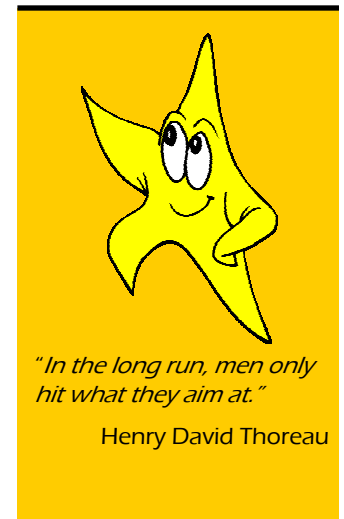
